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About Institution :

Shahu Shikshan Sanstha is one of the famous educational Institutions in Maharashtra, which runs 88 Institutes. It was established in 1980. It aims to support the unreached & deprived class students. It runs boardings, Libraries, Nurseries, Primary Schools, High Schools, Jr.&Sr. Colleges, D.Ed., B.Ed., B.P.Ed. IT. Colleges and law collages .

Introduction :

Vasundhara Kala Mahavidyalaya is a non-profit making, non-political, non-communal, social, voluntary orngnisation. It was found in the year 2000 by prof. Laxmanrao Dhobale who is well known political leader in Maharashtra. The college campus is sufficiently large. It has spacious Library, Class rooms, and Halls, Garden, Play ground, Gymnasium, Ladies room, Reading room & canteen facility. The college is affiliated to the PAH Solapur University, Solapur. The College is Accredited with 'B' Grade with CGPA2.23 by NAAC.

College Location :

The college is situated at Jule Solapur. Distance from main city to this college is hardly 4 km. The college campus is situated at a distance of 6 km. both from Railway Station and Solapur Bus Stand and at least 500 meters away from Vijapur road and Hotagi road.

Aims and Objectives:

The main objective of this institution is to serve the people who are educationally and culturally backward, and to uplift them by imparting education and to give adequate training to manage and maintain themselves in the rapidly changing world. We aim to support the students from deprived classes to acquire higher education. Various activities are arranged to support the students, Scholars, performers in the college. They are rewarded by certificates of honour for their outstanding achievements through out the year.

Infrastructure :

1) Teaching Staff: .

The college has a highly qualified staff, with considerable teaching experience and they are devoted to their tasks. Teachers do their best to understand the academic and the personal problems of the students by cultivating closeness and intimacy.

2) Library:

The college library is rich with several books on several topics and subjects, at the same time it subscribes popular magazines in Hindi, English, Marathi, including many news papers. Library is well furnished with comfortable furniture and other equipments. There are many books available to take home and also to study in the reading room. Several copies of every text book are available for the benefit of those who can't afford to buy them. The college runs book bank scheme for the economically backward students. Collage has subscription to e-journals and N list.

3) Class rooms :

The college has very comfortable and suitable class rooms with proper sitting arrangements, fans, green board with proper ventilation.

4) Women's Hostel :

Considering the qualitative performance of the college, the students from remote villages of South Solapur are seeking admission. Knowing the need of the time a well furnished women's hostel is constructed under the XII plan of UGC. The intake capacity of the hostel is 32. The management is concerned about the security and safety of the girls. Spacious rooms, separate study hall and dining hall with all amenities are made available.

Activities :

Sports : The college provides the students with the best opportunities to develop their personality through participation in the following.

a) Indoor and Outdoor Games :

Chess, Athletics, Cricket, Volleyball, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho, football, Wrestling, and Fencing. Judo.

b) Intra-mural activities:

Inter-class tournaments in various games and sports are organized through out the year.e.g.-Chess, Kabaddi, Cricket, Athletics, Volleyball, Kho-Kho etc.

c) Extra-mural activities:

Participation at the inter collegiate tournaments in various games and sports throughout the year organized by the university and other sports organizations, state-level tournaments, National level etc. The college has excelled in almost all the games at various levels, amongst the most prominent events. Winning in cricket, volleyball, Kho-Kho, Kabaddi, chess has become a regular feature of the college.

National Service Scheme (N.S.S.)

The N.S.S. Unit of the college is actively involved in organizing various activities that provide an excellent opportunity to the students to develop their personality and to nurture social responsibility. Students who enroll as N.S.S. volunteers are expected to undertake 120 hours community development work. Students who wish to enroll as N.S.S. volunteers should contact the N.S.S. programme officers as soon as the term begins. It is the unit of 100 volunteers.

Competitive Exam. Guidance Centre :

The centre prepares the students for the various competitive exams conducted by U.P.S.C., M.P.S.C, R.R.B., SET, NET, Banking and other Civil and Administrative examinations. The classes are run daily after 12.30 p.m. The Crash courses or rapid courses are run by the centre. The students those who are interested have to go through the entrance test organized by college.

Cultural Association :

The cultural association provides a platform for students to display their talents in theater, music & art. This association encourages and trains students to participate in cultural activities organized within and outside the state. Members of the association have done us proud by winning second spot/ place in Solapur University "Youth Festival".

The Internal Complaints Committee (ICC)

The internal complaints committee is established in college as per the sexual Harassment of women at workplace Prevention, Prohibition and redressal act 2013. The committee effectively implements the act as per University guidelines and it is highly successful in making our college campus zero tolerance zone.

Anti-ragging committee

The anti- ragging committee is established in college as per Indian Penal Code and U.G.C. regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in Higher Educational Institutions 2009.

It effectively works to ensure complete prohibition of ragging in college campus by providing safe and secure environment for the students.

Student Counseling :

This cell provides facilities for a group and individual counseling. The cell has a professional counselor / the orpist who solve the problems of students on specific days as per the schedule notified on the college notice board. Group counseling sessions covers all the students and address the issues of common interest and concern. Students in need of counseling can approach the teacher incharge at the counseling room during working hours on all working days.

Y.C.M.O.U. Study Centre :

It was started in the year 2004. The centre runs degree courses giving opportunities for the students who are already working and far from higher education.

Associations / Mandals :

The college has different associations to meet the diverse needs of students to instill the good manners, habits and confidence. These associations help to turn the potential into creative power. All round development of the personality of students is made with the help of activities of various Associations / Mandals. e.g.- English, Marathi, Hindi Literary Association, Social science Mandals & Students welfare Association etc.

Literary Association :

The College literary association nurtures the literary talent and communication skills of students. The association organizes debates, Elocution competitions, Poetry recitation, workshops on reading and writing skills etc. The college wallpaper activity is supported by this association is an expression of the multi faceted talent that the student possesses. The association also trains the students in various facts of public speaking such as group discussion and debate competition.

Social Science Mandal :

The Mandal makes the students aware about the current and burning issues in the city, state and also national or International issues. This supports the students in many events which nurtures the students internal and external personality and talent.

Student Welfare Association :

The association aims to develop leadership and organizational capabilities in the students. The association organizes the election of students council in the college to solve the problems of students.

Facilities :

1) Book Bank Scheme : The college always helps the students in one or another way. Book bank scheme is it's integral part. The students who are economically backward or those who are unable to purchase the books are helped under this scheme.

2) Students aid fund : The objective of this scheme is to support the poor students financially to pay their tuition / examination fees in part or full or to purchase books or to meet any other expense as approved by the college authorities. Every student contributes Rs. 10 per annum for this fund.

3) Common Room For Girls : Girl students can utilize the common room that has a bathroom attached which is cozy, comfortable & safe.

4) Canteen : The college runs a canteen that caters to the faculty and students. The menu is adequate delicious and nutritious and is made available to all at nominal rate.

5) First Aid : The first aid kit is kept for the students. The students in need of First-Aid can obtain the same from college office.

6) Internet : Our college offers internet facility to its staff and students at free of cost, through Library and B.C.A. Department.

Research Centre :

The College has Solapur university research center for History, & research supervisors in Marathi, Hindi, English, Geogroyhy, Sociology Pol-Science, Economics & Physical Education Where the research work is executed for Ph.D. degree.

Museum :

The College has Historical & Arcological Museum well equipped with various ancient, middle age things.

Short Term Courses :

The college runs Short Term Courses for the all round development of the students personality and to enable them to face the challenges. The various courses run by the various departments in our college are Spoken English, Tourism management and Administration, Modi Script, Letter Writing, basic course in Marathi Mudrit shodhan, Hair Fashion and Beauty Parlor. Letter writing, Core Java, Yoga, Karate, Tally ERP 9 with GST etc.

Mentoring System :

The college has introduced mentoring system to keep students update and to enable them to keep pace with the changing World. Through this system the faculty guides the students time to time. Every faculty has been allotted 30 students to cater their diverse needs related to academic performance as well as their personal problems.

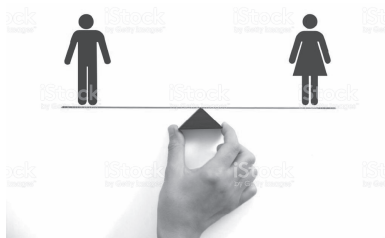
